Other information about the centre of Milton Keynes and what it has to offer:

Both of these hotels offer a great location, if delegates are travelling with others, who will not attend the Conference as there is much to offer in the immediate area of Central Milton Keynes, together with great train

links south to London, north to Birmingham or coach links west to Oxford and east to Cambridge for days out.

Central Milton Keynes railway station is just 5 minutes walk away from each hotel (south east of the hotel, along Midsummer Boulevard). This will provide an opportunity for delegates to visit London during their stay, if they so wish. Virgin trains now offer a direct route to London, Euston station in 35 minutes. It is likely to be an exciting time to travel to London, in the run up to the opening of the Olympic Games.

In the opposite direction, walking north west along Midsummer Boulevard from the hotel, you will find yourselves in the main shopping centre, 'The Centre: MK', web link <http://www.thecentremk.com/>. This is packed with shops, department stores and places to eat and coffee shops.

Continuing along Midsummer Boulevard is Campbell Park, one of MK's many big and varied open park spaces. From here you can enjoy a walk along the tow path of the historic Grand Union Canal.

Within easy walking distance you can reach Xscape, web link <http://www.xscape.co.uk/milton-keynes> (next to the shopping centre) which offers the UK's largest indoor snow slope for skiing and tobogganing, an indoor climbing wall, 'Airkix' indoor skydiving, 10 pin bowling alley, cinema screens, and other entertainment, bars and restaurants and sports retail shops.

Accommodation at Woburn Village

Woburn village is a wonderfully relaxing place to stay and enjoy the Conference. It has many pubs and restaurants for you to socialise in during the evenings. Come and enjoy, what we hope will be, a warm sunny week in England in this historic village setting.
