



13th International Workshop on the Physics of Compressible Turbulent Mixing, UK, 16-20 July, 2012

We write to offer you an update on the preparations for the 13th International Workshop on the Physics of Compressible Turbulent Mixing (IWPCTM13) Conference which will be held at The Sculpture Gallery, Woburn, England, starting with registration and light refreshments, from 2pm, on Sunday afternoon 15 July and finishing at lunchtime on Friday 20 July 2012.

Abstract Acceptance: Announced 14th and 15th March 2012

We are very pleased to let you know that we have been able to accept the majority of the abstracts which we have received for the Conference Programme. An outcome of the Review Panel decision has been sent to each person who has submitted an abstract, for either an oral or poster presentation. If you have submitted an abstract and have not heard from us please do get in touch as it is likely that we are unaware of your submission. We would like to have an opportunity to rectify this situation.

While we hope everyone will be able to attend the Workshop, we recognise that some of you may have to withdraw. Consequently, we have drawn up a waiting list for those authors who we were unable to offer an oral presentation in the draft programme.

Conference Registration – request for your personal registration details, closing date 30 April 2012

It is particularly important for presenting authors and those requiring visas to complete the registration at an early stage. If you have not already done so then please register at <http://www.iwpctm.org/iwpctm13/register.php> Registration closes on Monday 30 April 2012.

The registration fee of £550 (£360 for students) should be paid before 15 June 2012.

The registration fee includes the Workshop banquet on the evening of Thursday 19th July. In order to assist us with our planning, we would appreciate it if, during registration, you could confirm your anticipated attendance at the banquet. We will be offering the opportunity for anyone accompanying delegates to attend the banquet. Details will be posted on the web site once the cost of this has been determined.

Visas: Letter of Invitation

We would like to assist those who will need to apply for a visa by preparing and issuing a Letter of Invitation.

We have received requests from some delegates and are in the process of issuing your letters.

If you are aware that you will need a visa to travel to the UK, please send us your details including the information your Embassy will wish to see in the letter. Some Embassy's ask for the following; Passport number, Date of Issue, Date of Expiry, In the name of, Date of Birth, Place of Birth, Nationality. Please check the details your Embassy will expect to see. Please also provide information for your planned arrival and departure dates for your visit. The letter will be addressed to your office, again please give details.

Reduced Registration Fees

The Local Organising Committee have discussed and agreed that they would like to offer some financial assistance to support students and young scientists worldwide (loosely those under 40 years old) who have been accepted to present either an oral or poster presentation at the Conference. If you feel that you do not have the funding to support your attendance at this event, from your organisation, industry or a research grant we would be happy to hear from you.

To apply for this opportunity we would ask that you offer two paragraphs with a brief outline of your work, or reiterating your abstract title if this is your current focus along with some detail of your financial circumstances and why they are tight. We would like to assist a limited number of delegates by offering a small amount of funding which is likely to reduce the full registration rate, £550, to the student registration rate £360; a further small reduction may be made to the student registration fee of some participants. We look forward to hearing from you.

If you have already contacted us with this question, we would ask that you prepare the two paragraphs which we are asking for and send them as soon as you are able. The Review Panel is looking to make an early decision on this and would like to receive all requests by Monday 2nd April 2012.
